**SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR
THE 2018 CALNENA MISSION CRITICAL TRAINING EVENT IN LA JOLLA**

The California Chapter of the National Emergency Number Association (CALNENA) will hold its Mission Critical Training Event (MCTE) at the Hyatt Regency, La Jolla, CA on February 26 - March 1, 2018. The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$3,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2018 to attend the CALNENA MCTE. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$3,000 for FY 2017-2018.

The attached State of California Travel Reimbursement Rates reference document provides information regarding the State's reimbursement rates for FY 2017-2018. The second page of the reference document reflects the ATA eligible lodging reimbursement rate for the state of California.
