**SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR THE 2017 CALNENA SPRING MEETING**

The California Chapter of the National Emergency Number Association (CALNENA) will hold its Spring Meeting at the Monterey Tides Hotel in Monterey, CA on May 4, 2017. The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$3,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-2017 to attend the CALNENA Spring Meeting. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$3,000 for FY 2016-2017.

The attached State of California Travel Reimbursement Rates reference document provides information regarding the State's reimbursement rates for FY 2016-2017. The second page of the reference document reflects the ATA eligible lodging reimbursement rate for the state of California.
