SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR THE 2017 CALNENA FALL MEETING

The California Chapter of the National Emergency Number Association (CALNENA) will hold its Fall Meeting at the Double Tree by Hilton Golf Resort Palm Springs in Cathedral City, CA on Friday, November 3, 2017. The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$3,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2018 to attend the CALNENA Fall Meeting. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$3,000 for FY 2017-2018.
