CALNENA Mission Critical Training Event (MCTE)

The California Chapter of the National Emergency Number Association is pleased to present the "Mission Critical Training Event" to be held at the Hyatt Regency La Jolla, San Diego, Ca. February 27-March 2, 2017. This event will focus on training and providing contemporary information that affects the 9-1-1 Profession. Full day Breakout Training Courses (ETC) and the 4th annual Industry Leader's Forum will kickoff the event on February 27th with Key Notes and Breakout Sessions to follow on February 28th.

This Call for Papers invites NENA members, industry associates, business professionals and educators to submit a proposal for a Breakout Session (to include but not limited to a workshop or panel discussion) and/or an ETC all day presentation. Topics must be directly related to the police/fire/EMS emergency communications field. All entries will be considered, but we are proactively searching for fresh, innovative content. Please see the following guidelines for your submittal and thank you for your support of the 9-1-1 profession, CALNENA and proactive participation in our upcoming event.

Exclusive Training Courses (ETC) Presenters - CALNENA provides the room, tables and chairs for the presentation, but registration, monetary collection (if any), equipment/materials, etc., are to be provided by the Presenter. If you are presenting an ETC and not attending the Mission Critical Training Event, registration via www.calnena.org is not required. You must, however, submit your proposal via the link provided below.

Breakout Session Presenters - Proposals topics will be evaluated based on the quality, timeliness, relevance, practicality and focus of the topic. Historical data from surveys and evaluations of previous events will be used to determine potential attendees/interest. All sessions are to be vendor-neutral, if you would like to be vendor-specific please consider becoming a sponsor which affords you the opportunity to do so. Vendor presentations **MUST BE NEW** and not previously presented at MCTE. Registration instructions will be provided to presenters once presentations are accepted. Presenters are to furnish their own supplies (laptop, flipchart, markers, handouts, etc.) as appropriate. CALNENA provides the projector, microphone and screen in each breakout room. All presenters/panel members must be listed in the proposal. Presenters are responsible for all of their travel, lodging, meals and materials. All PSPA personnel/government employees who are selected to present a Breakout Session will receive a \$200 discount on their MCTE registration. However, only one discounted registration per topic will be available if there are multiple presenters per session, i.e. panel discussion, team teaching, etc.
